Scholarships

Brian Keith Greene (BKG)-This scholarship award is only available to a Beta Nu Alpha in good standing with the chapter. Winning applicant (s) will receive a minimum of \$1,000. The award is nonrenewable and current recipients cannot re-apply.

Te-Andre Brown (TAB)-This scholarship award is only available to Sophmores, Juniors and Seniors at Florida A&M University. Winning applicant (s) will receive a minimum of \$1,000. The award is nonrenewable and current recipients cannot re-apply. Members of Alpha Phi Alpha cannot apply for this scholarship.

Jeffrey Alan Lamar (JAL)-This scholarship award is only available to incoming Freshman. Winning applicant (s) will receive up to \$1,000. The award is nonrenewable and current recipients cannot re-apply.



Scholarships

Eugene R. Cromartie (ERC)-This Scholarship is only available to MSIII Cadets (Junior). Winning applicant (s) will receive a minimum of \$750. The award is nonrenewable and current recipients cannot re-apply.

Alvin Bryant (AB)-This Scholarship is only available to MSII Cadets (Sophomore). Winning applicant (s) will receive a minimum of \$500.

Counsel of Colonels (COC)-This Scholarship is only available to MSI Cadets (Freshman). Winning applicant (s) will receive a minimum of \$250.
